

Alien Associations

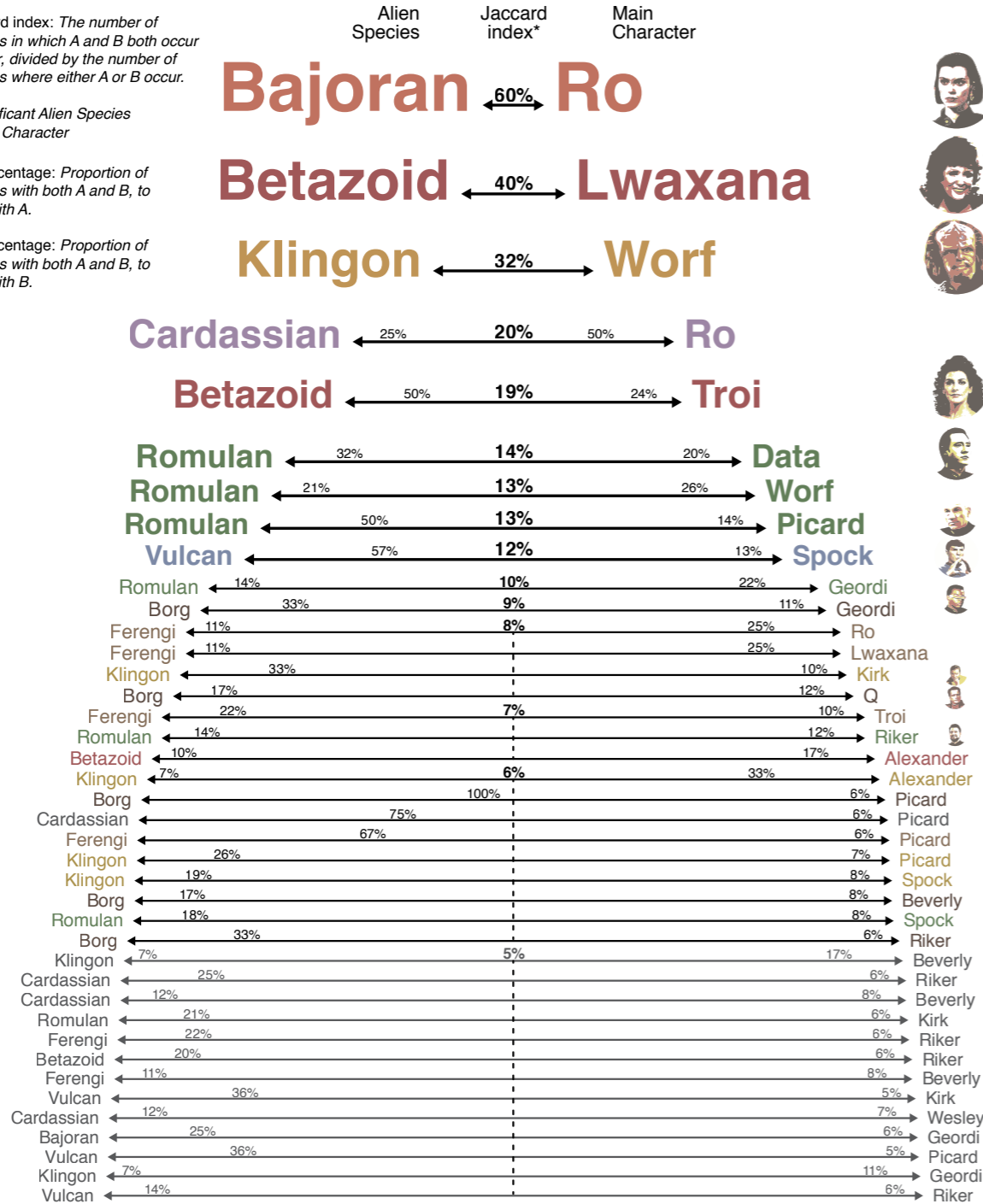
Some alien species are more or less strongly associated with certain main characters or with certain themes. This is illustrated by a study of co-occurrence.

* Jaccard index: The number of episodes in which A and B both occur together, divided by the number of episodes where either A or B occur.

A: Significant Alien Species
B: Main Character

Left percentage: Proportion of episodes with both A and B, to those with A.

Left percentage: Proportion of episodes with both A and B, to those with B.



Note that a recurring crew member's species is not recorded as an alien occurrence; Spock is associated with Vulcans because he tends to be a main character when other Vulcans are around.

* Jaccard index: The number of episodes in which A and B both occur together, divided by the number of episodes where either A or B occur.
